Did you know that?

Cotabato province posted a total population of 1,275,185 as of May 1, 2020.

Among the municipalities in the province, the City of Kidapawan posted the highest population of 160,791 persons, followed by the municipality of Midsayap with 117,365 persons and M'lang ranked third with 98,195 persons.

Top five most populated barangays in the province in terms of population were Poblacion, Kidapawan City with 28,824 persons; Poblacion, Kabacan with 17,506 person; Poblacion, Carmen with 12,957 persons; Dado, Alamada with 11,912 and Kayaga, Kabacan with 11,716 persons.
