## SOCCSKSARGEN's Inflation Rate for the Bottom 30% Income Household Eases to 2.8% in July 2019

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#### YEAR-ON-YEAR INFLATION RATES

In July 2019, the slower annual rates noted in all the commodity groups has resulted to the easing of the year-on-year inflation rate for the bottom 30% income households. In the SOCCSKSARGEN Region, from 3.5% in June 2019 to 2.8% in July of the same year, it is the lowest annual increment recorded for the first six months of 2019. Although Fuel, Light and Water still posted the highest inflation rate, it decreased by 1.6 percentage points from a 9.1 inflation rate in June 2019.






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Overall, prices on food commodities slowed down to 1.0 percent in July 2019 from 1.6 percent in the previous month as slower price mark-ups were recorded in the indices of Cereals (-7.4% from -6.0%), Rice (-6.4% from -4.5%), Cereal Preparations (3.0% from 3.6%), Fruits and Vegetables (11.2% from 12.2%), Meat (1.2% from 1.8%) and Miscellaneous Foods (3.5% from 5.0%).

In contrast, higher annual rates were noted in the indices of Corn (-12.0% to -11.5%), Dairy Products (3.2% to 3.4%), Eggs (3.5% to 3.9%) and Fish (8.0% to 10.7%).

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#### **CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, JULY 2019**

The CPI for All Items for the Bottom 30% of Income Household in SOCCSKSARGEN Region was noted at 242.0 index points in July 2019. The average retail price of goods and services in the market basket went up to 142.0 percent compared to the 2000 base year. This means that, on the average, about P242.00 is needed to purchase the same goods and services worth P100.00 in the 2000 based year.

The July 2019 CPI was lower by 0.3 index points from 242.3 index points in June 2019. Among the commodity groups, Fuel, Light and Water (FLW) at 263.7 index points, posted the highest decrease at about 1.2 index points lower from 264.9 index points in June 2019.



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For FLW, Fuel posted the highest decrease in prices at 263.5 index points, about 1.7 lower than the previous month's 265.2 index points. This was contrary to Light which gained an increase of 0.7 index points. Water, on the other hand, sustained its previous month's price mark-up of 240.9 index points.
