LGU Mlang and PSA Cotabato Provincial Statistical Office Conducts the 2022 Community Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Municipal Level Training

The Local Government Unit of Mlang, Cotabato in partnership with the Philippine Statistics Authority – Cotabato Provincial Statistical Office conducts an eight-days Training on the 2022 Community-based Monitoring System (CBMS) data collection among households on September 2-9, 2022 at the Municipal Rooftop, Mlang, Cotabato.

The 2022 CBMS aims to generate updated and disaggregated data necessary for targeting beneficiaries; conduct more

comprehensive poverty analysis and needs prioritization; and to provide information that will enable a system of public spending that warrants government allocation on areas and populace that are most wanting.

Thorough discussions on the concepts and definitions of the 2022 CBMS Enumerator's Manual is to be undertaken to ensure complete and accurate collection of data from each household in the locality particularly on their basic demographic, social, economic and health characteristics, some characteristics of their housing unit/household, agricultural activities, state of their food insecurity, data on disaster risk and reduction management practices and data on new emerging trends such as e-commerce, digital economy, and financial inclusion.





The municipal level training is attended by 80 hired personnel (including the Team Supervisors and CBMS Area Supervisors), hired Head CBMS Area Supervisor, MPDC selected personnel and

selected PSA provincial personnel.
