# Headline Inflation Rate in Cotabato Province Up by 4.8% in May 2022

#### YEAR-ON-YEAR INFLATION RATES

The average inflation rate or the annual rate of change on the prices of goods and services in the market basket in Cotabato Province went up by 4.8% in May 2022 from 4.3% in April 2022. A difference of 0.5 percentage point from the previous month. From May 2021 to May 2022, the highest monthly inflation rate was on August 2021 at 6.1% and the lowest was recorded in March 2021 at 2.6%. Inflation rate of Cotabato Province from January to May 2022 is at 3.8% (Table 1 and Figure 1).



The year-on-year inflation rate or the annual average inflation rate on the prices of goods and services in the market basket was highest in 2021 at 5.5 percent. The lowest average inflation was in 2019 at 1.0 percent. Lowest monthly inflation was recorded in October 2019 at -1.6 %. Headline Inflation for All Items in May exhibited an uptrend of 1.0% in 2019 to 5.5% in 2021 (Table 2)

#### **INFLATION RATE BY COMMODITY GROUP**

The major contributors to the May 2022 inflation rate were Transport at 1.3% (from 16.3% to 17.6%); Food and Non- Alcoholic Beverages at 0.8% (from 2.8% to 3.6%); Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other fuels at 0.4% (from 4.6% to 5.0%); Recreation Sports and Culture at 0.2% (from 1.2% to 1.4%), Personal Care and Miscellaneous Goods and Services at 0.1% (from 3.2% to 3.3%).

Among the 13 major commodity groups, Transport recorded the highest inflation in May 2022 at 1.3%. Lower price hikes were noted in Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco and Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance at 0.4% respectively. Followed by Information and Communication at 0.3%; Clothing and Footwear and Health at 0.2%, Education, Restaurants and Accommodation and Financial Services sustained their previous month's rate (Table 3).

### **Technical Notes**

Headline Inflation Rate refers to the rate of change in the CPI, a measure of the

average price of a standard basket of goods and services

consumed by a typical family.

Base Period/Year this refers to the period, usually a year, at which the index

number/points is set to 100. It is the point of the index

number series.

Consumer Price Index the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and

services commonly purchased by households relative to a

base year.

**Inflation Rate** the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change in the

CPI expressed in percent.

Market basket refers to a sample of goods and services that are commonly

purchased and bought by an average Filipino household.

Weights a system that considers the relevance of the components of

the index.
