## PSA-Sultan Kudarat Conducts Information Dissemination on Statistical Products and Civil Registration and National ID Services at Tacurong National High School

The Philippine Statistics Authority-Sultan Kudarat (PSA-SK), in collaboration with Tacurong National High School (TNHS), marked the 35th Civil Registration Month



celebration with a successful information dissemination on PSA's Statistical Products and Civil Registration and National ID Services. The event held at TNHS Gymnasium in New Isabela, Tacurong City from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM on 18 February 2025 and was attended by one hundred forty (140) Grade 12 students. This initiative effectively raised awareness about the significance of accurate civil registration and vital statistics in the school community.

Marifi P. De Asis, OIC-Chief Statistical Specialist, emphasized the crucial role of civil registration in establishing identity and accessing essential social services, ensuring students can fully participate in society and receive vital educational opportunities.

The seminar featured informative presentations covering:

- 1. Basic Information on the Civil Registration;
- 2. 2022-2023 Vital Statistics of Sultan Kudarat Province; and
- 3. Updates on National ID Frontline Services.

A question-and-answer session followed the presentations, allowing participants to address their concerns. Informative IEC materials were also distributed.

Adding to the engagement, a lively Civil Registration Vital Statistics (CRVS) Quiz Bee was administered by Roselyn G. Foman, Supervising Statistical Specialist to test students' ability to comprehend all the discussions. Among the 16 participants, Precious Pearl Cabajan emerged as the Champion, followed by John Gabriel Garde (1st runner-up) and Juven Lance Javier (2nd runner-up).







The event was deemed a resounding success, significantly increased awareness among students and the community about the importance of registering vital events and obtaining civil registration documents. This initiative is expected to foster a stronger, more informed community, thus improving the level of civil registration in the country particularly in Sultan Kudarat Province.
