## PSA Sultan Kudarat Province Conducts Information Dissemination on PSA's Statistical Products, Civil Registration and National ID Services at Kalanawe II National High School

The PSA-Sultan Kudarat Provincial Office conducted an information dissemination on civil registration and National ID at Kalanawe II National High School on 20 February 2025 at 1:30 p.m. This was the fourth in a series of information dissemination activity by PSA-SK to streamline basic information on civil registration and related statistics, and to relay National ID frontline services and updates. The activity was participated by 127 senior high school students including faculty staff of the said school.

The School Principal, Al B. Casquero, conveyed his gratitude to the efforts of PSA-SK for its strategic approach to empower younger generations with knowledge about their rights and responsibilities regarding civil documentation as they prepare for their future educational endeavors.

Roselyn G. Fornan, Supervising Statistical Specialist (SSS) of PSA- SK, expressed her gratitude towards Kalanawe II National High School for accepting the provincial office's invitation in conducting an information dissemination in their school. In addition, SSS Fornan highlighted in her message that by engaging with educational institutions, the PSA seeks to promote statistical literacy and encourage the use of its services among young individuals, particularly to the high school students, which is crucial as they shift to higher education.

One of the highlights of the activity was the lecture on the basic information of Civil Registration by Administrative Aide VI, Rowelynn S. Movida, presentation on the



highlights of the 2022 and 2023 Vital Statistics of Sultan Kudarat Province, by SSS Roselyn G. Fornan, and National ID Frontline Services and Updates by National ID Administrative Clerk, Sheanne Mae B. Mantos.

Following this, an open forum was organized to entertain the inquiries and concerns of the students about National ID and Civil Registration Services.

Furthermore, a fun CRVS Quiz Bee was conducted to gauge participants' familiarity with the presented vital statistics and basic information on civil registration procedures.



Keith Shanyllf Pascua emerged as the CRVS Quiz Bee Champion after а challenging final round. Renzy Nabor hailed as the 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up and Remylina Moreno as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up. The PSA has been conducting this kind of activity in schools to inform students about the significance of civil registration in line with the 35<sup>th</sup> Civil Registration Month (CRM) Celebration.
