PSA-Sultan Kudarat Sets to Conduct 2024 POPCEN-CBMS Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP) and Listing of Building Construction (LoBC)

The Philippine Statistics Authority-Sultan Kudarat Provincial Office (PSA-SK) is set to conduct the Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP) and Listing of Building Constructions (LoBC) in the entire Sultan Kudarat Province starting 03 March 2025 to April 2025.

This geotagging activity is a component of the 2024 Census of Population and Community-Based Monitoring System (POPCEN-CBMS) operations. The Geotagging of SFGP aims to gather relevant and timely information about service facilities, government projects, and natural resources collected at the local level by marking points into digitized maps.

The LoBC, on the other hand, involves the collection ongoing/existing building constructions' information, including the type, value, and period of construction activity and other building permit information. intends to improve generation of construction statistics further.

In preparation to this activity, PSA-SK conducted Provincial Level Training for the 2024 POPCEN-CBMS Geotagging of SFGP and LoBC on 24-27 February 2025 held at the Binoy's Arcade, Tacurong City.

Twenty (20) Map Data Collectors (MDCs), four (4) Map Data Processors (MDPs) and one (1) Map Data Reviewer (MDR) were hired and trained by PSA-SK for the said undertaking.

The MDCs will be deployed in their respective areas of assignment in Sultan Kudarat Province and will be responsible in geotagging the necessary map features while the MDPs and MDR are tasked to process, check and verify the geotagged features accordingly.
