## PSA Sultan Kudarat Concludes the 35th Civil Registration Month Celebration

The Philippine Statistics Authority - Sultan Kudarat (PSA-SK) successfully concluded the monthlong celebration of the 35th Civil Registration Month with a theme "Building a Resilient, Agile, and Future-fit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS) System" with a closing ceremony held on 04 March 2025 from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm at the New Executive Building, City Hall, Tacurong City.

The closing ceremony was graced by the Local Civil Registrars, teachers and students from six participating schools namely: Tacurong National High School (TNHS), Virginia F. Griño National High School (VFGNHS), Notre Dame of Katiko, Inc. (NDKI), Kalanawi II National High School (KNHS), President Quirino Treasured Child School Inc.
