SOCCSKSARGEN's economy grew by 6.9 percent in 2018

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SOCCSKSARGEN's economy expanded by 6.9 percent in 2018, slower than the 8.3 percent growth in 2017.

In 2018, the total value of the final goods and services produced in the SOCCSKSARGEN Region, as measured through the GRDP, was valued at P246.69 billion at constant 2000 prices, higher than the P230.78 billion recorded the previous year. (*Table 1*)

Services remained to account for the largest share of the regional economy at 40.8 percent in 2018, slightly higher than its 40.2 percent share in 2017. The share of Industry also expanded to 37.2 percent in 2018 from the previous year's 36.8 percent. AHFF contributed 22.0 percent to the region's total economic output in 2018, lower than its 23.0 percent share in 2017.

By sub-industries, Manufacturing had the biggest share in the total regional economic output at 24.9 percent. It was followed by Agriculture and Forestry (18.4%), Other Services (8.9%), Construction (8.7%) and Transportation, Storage and Communication (7.2%). (Table 2)

Services grew by 8.4 percent in 2018, faster than the 7.8 percent recorded the previous year propelled by higher growths in four (4) of its sub-industries.



Public Administration and Defense; Compulsory Social Security went up from 7.2 percent in 2017 to 13.6 percent in 2018. Transportation, Storage and Communication expanded from 6.1 percent to 8.4 percent. Trade and Repair grew at a faster pace in 2018 at 8.8 percent from 7.9 percent in 2017. Financial Intermediation also grew by 8.3 percent in 2018, higher than its 7.9 percent performance in 2017. Other Services expanded by 8.3 percent in 2018, slower than the 10.6 percent recorded in 2017. Real Estate, Renting and Business Activities posted a growth of 4.4 percent, sluggish when compared to the 6.5 percent recorded the previous year. (*Table 3*)

Industry sustained its momentum although at a slower rate of 8.0 percent from 8.4 percent in 2017 despite posting positive growths in all of its sub-industries. Construction went up by 13.6 percent maintaining its double digit growth of 10.2 percent in 2017. Electricity, Gas and Water posted a reversal of 5.0 percent from a contraction of 7.0 percent in 2017.

Manufacturing, which accounted for the bulk of Industry, grew by 6.6 percent, slower than the 10.3 percent posted in 2017. Mining and Quarrying slackened from 8.0 percent to 5.6 percent in 2018.

Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry and Fishery slowed down from 8.7 percent in 2017 to 2.5 percent in 2018 due to a contraction in Fishing. Fishing slumped from 11.2 percent in 2017 to a contraction of 3.9 percent in 2018 due to a drop in municipal fishery output in 2018. Agriculture and Forestry posted a slower growth of 3.8 percent from 8.2 percent in 2017. This was due to the decrease in the production of corn, poultry and livestock. (*Table 3*)

In terms of contribution to growth, Services, which contributed 3.4 percentage points, was the top contributor to the region's economic growth of 6.9 percent in 2018. It was followed by Industry which chipped in 2.9 percentage points while AHFF shared 0.6 percentage



points. Among the sub-industries, Manufacturing contributed 1.6 percentage points and Construction 1.1 percentage point. (*Table 4*)

Among the regions in the country, Bicol Region recorded the fastest growth at 8.9 percent, followed by Davao Region at 8.6 percent and MIMAROPA at 8.6 percent and. Nine (9) out of the 17 regions, including the

SOCCSKSARGEN Region, recorded decelerations in 2018. Twelve (12) regions posted lower growths than the national growth rate of 6.2 percent.

SOCCSKSARGEN Region ranked 10th among the regions in terms of growth rate. *(Table 5)*

Per capita GRDP in SOCCSKSARGEN Region was estimated at Php50,644 in 2018, about 4.9 percent higher from the previous year and 41.4 percent lower than the national per capita GDP of Php86,370.

Highest per capita GDP in 2018 was posted by the NCR at Php253,893 which was almost three times higher than the national figure, followed by CALABARZON (Php104,708) and CAR (Php87,722). (Table 6)

By contribution to the 2018 GDP growth rate, NCR was the top contributor to the national growth at 1.8 percentage points followed by CALABARZON at 1.2 percentage points and Central Luzon at 0.7 percentage point. SOCCSAKSARGEN Region contributed 0.2 percentage point. (Table 7)

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
