HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SURALLAH

Based on the results of the 2015 Census of Population



Occupied housing units in Municipality of Surallah reached 20, 147

Based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015), the number of occupied housing units in Surallah as of August 1, 2015 was 20,147. This is 2,937 higher than the 2010 housing units reported, and 6,648 more than the 13,499 occupied housing units posted in 2000.

There were 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units

A total of 20,300 households and 84,426 persons in 20,147 housing units in the province resulting to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, and a ratio of 4.19 persons per occupied housing units.

Majority were single-type houses

In 2015, single houses made up of 96.64 percent of the total occupied housing units in Surallah. About 2.30 percent were duplex type, while 0.88 percent were multi-unit residential buildings. By, comparison, in 2010, single houses accounted for 96.80 percent of the total occupied housing units, 0.93 percent were duplex buildings or houses and, 0.15 percent were multi-unit residential.

40.73 percent of the occupied housing units had outer walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa

In 2015, 40.73 percent of the occupied housing units in Surallah had outer walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa, lower than the 41.70 and 52.60 percent recorded in 2010 and 2000, respectively. Outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone comprised of 33.22 percent and 16.91 percent used half concrete/brick/stone and half wood.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials increase in 2015

The number of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron or aluminum increased in 2015. Almost 82.97 percent of occupied housing units are made of galvanized iron or aluminum. This figure increased by 6.25 percentage points from 76.72 recorded in 2010. On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units that used bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw for the roofs declined from 20.08 percent in 2010 to 11.53 percent in 2015.

Majority of the households lived in house and lot that they owned

Of the total 20,390 households in 2015, majority (or 60.57 percent) owned or were owner like possession of house and lot they occupied. Also, 26.41 percent of the households occupied house they owned with lot that were rent-free but with consent of the owner, while 2.90 percent are rent house/room including lot.

Most of the houses in uses electricity for lighting

In 2015, electricity was the main fuel used by the households for lighting that accounted to 84.14 percent. The number of households using kerosene (gaas) and solar lamps accounted for 8.67 percent and 4.26 percent, respectively. There were 8 households which reported no fuel used for lighting.

Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking

About 26.28 percent of households obtained water for drinking from own use faucet community water system, while 15.61 percent were from shared tubed/piped deep well, followed by bottled water with 14 percent.

Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for cooking

About 34.65 percent of the total number of households in 2015 used water from community system (from own use faucet) for cooking. This was followed by households that used shared tubed/piped deep well and from own use tubed/piped deep well with 16.64 and 13.28 percent, respectively.
