

#### YEAR-ON-YEAR INFLATION RATES

Headline inflation rate or the annual rate of change on the prices of goods and services in the market basket in Cotabato Province accelerate to 6.4 percent in June 2022 from 4.8 percent in May 2022. This is higher than the regional and national levels at 5.7 percent and 6.1 percent respectively. This is the highest inflation rate recorded this year. Inflation in June 2021 was lower at 5.0 percent. The average inflation for All items for the first six months of the year stood at 4.2 percent. (Table 1 and Figure 1)

The acceleration in the Province inflation rate in June 2022 was mainly brought about by the higher annual increase growths in the index of food and non-alcoholic beverages at 5.5 percent; transport, 22.6 percent; and Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and other Fuels at 5.7 percent. Also contributing to the uptrend in the overall inflation during the period were higher annual increments in the indices of the following commodity groups as compared with their previous month's inflation rates:

- a. Personal Care, and Miscellaneous Goods and Services, 4.8 percent;
- b. Furnishing household equipment and routine household maintenance, 3.9 percent;
- c. Clothing and Footwear, 2.0 percent;
- d. Information and Communication, 2.1 percent
- e. Recreation and Accommodation Services, 3.3 percent;

Meanwhile, inflation rates slowed down in the indices of Health at 1.0 percent.

On the contrary, only Alcoholic, Beverages and Tobacco shows downtrend of 9.3 percent in June from 9.5 percent in May 2022.

The rest of the commodity groups retained their previous month's inflation rates or had zero percent annual growths. (Table 2).

For food index, it increased further by 5.5 percent in June 2022, from 3.6 percent in the previous month. In June 2021, food index was lower at 0.8 percent.

The annual growth rate of Cereals and cereals products (ND) index went up to 4.7 percent during the month, from 2.9 percent in the previous month. Meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals (ND) index also went up to 10.3 percent from 7.1 percent in the previous month. Fish and other seafood's (ND) index went up to 3.6 percent from 2.7 percent in the previous month. Sugar, confectionary and desserts (ND) went up to 19.6 percent from 17.1 percent in the previous month. Ready-made food and other food products n.e.c (ND) index of 5.3 percent from 3.7 percent. Milk, other dairy products and eggs index went up to 0.4 percent from (1.4) percent. Fruits and nuts index (0.5) percent from (7.6) percent in the previous month.

On the contrary, the food indices that were deflated are Oils and fats at 13.9 percent during the month from 14.0 percent from the previous month. Vegetables, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses at 8.5 percent from 8.7 percent.

The following food groups exhibited a high annual increment during the month:

- a) Cereals and cereal products, 4.7 percent;
- b) Meat and other parts of slaughter land animals. 10.3 percent:
- c) Vegetables, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses, 8.5 percent

#### **Technical Notes**

Headline Inflation Rate refers to the rate of change in the CPI, a measure of the average price of a

standard basket of goods and services consumed by a typical family.

Base Period/Year this refers to the period, usually a year, at which the index number/points is

set to 100. It is the point of the index number series.

**Consumer Price Index** the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly

purchased by households relative to a base year.

**Inflation Rate** the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change in the CPI expressed

in percent.

Market basket refers to a sample of goods and services that are commonly purchased and

bought by an average Filipino household.

**Weights** a system that considers the relevance of the components of the index.
