# VOLUME AND VALUE OF IMPORTED AND EXPORTED GOODS, SOCCSKSARGEN REGION: JULY 2021

## Total external trade up

The external trade in goods in SOCCSKSARGEN Region totaled to US\$186.550 million in July 2021, down by 32.7 percent from US\$140.535 million in July 2020 (Table 1).

#### Trade balance decrease

Balance of trade in goods (BoT-G) is the difference between the value of exports and imports. The (BoT-G) on July 2021 amounted to US\$62.410 million, about 1,200 times higher than the US\$51,517.00 the previous year (Table 1).

#### **Merchandise Trade**

SOCCSKSARGEN Region's export rose up by 77.1 percent to US\$124.480 million in July 2021 from US\$70.293 million in July 2020. The total volume of exports weighed at 104.053 million kilograms in July 2021 from 48.220 million kilograms in July 2020. Imports expenditures in July 2021 went down by 11.6 percent to US\$62.070 million from US\$70.242 million in July 2020. The volume of imports weighed 75.825 million kilograms in July 2021 from 185.706 million kilograms in July 2020 (Table 1).



# Skipjack was the top import commodity

The top import commodity was *Skipjack or striped bellied bonito* which amounted to US\$14.398 million accounting for 23.2 percent of the total value of imports of the region. It was followed by *Yellowfin tuna* at US\$6.497 million (10.5%); *Gas Oils* at US\$5.365 million (8.6%); *Other Portland Cement* at US\$4.777 million (7.7%); and *Other flat rolled products of iron plated or coated with tin of a thickness of less than 0.5 mm* at US\$4.337 million (7.0%). # China was the largest source of import goods

China was the region's largest import source in July 2021 at US\$11.937 million accounting for 19.2 percent of the total imports of the region. It was followed by *Taiwan* at US\$7.912 million with 12.7 percent; *Japan* at US\$6.769 million (10.9%); *Papua New Guinea* at US\$6.081 million (9.8%); and *Thailand* at US\$5.158 million (8.3%).

The leading imports in China was *Gas oils*, in terms of FOB. *Skipjack or stripe-bellied bonito* in Taiwan; in Japan, *other flat rolled products of iron plated or coated with tin, of a thickness of less than 0.5 mm;* in Papua New Guinea, *Yellowfin Tunas*; and *other refined sugar* in Thailand (Figure 2).

# Tuna in airtight containers were the top export goods

Tunas in airtight containers; Other Crude Oil; Pineapple in airtight container; Fruit Concentrates, and Fresh Pineapples were the top five export goods in terms of FOB Value. Tuna exports were valued at US\$31.485 million (25.3%), Other Crude Oil at US\$27.432 million (22.0%), Pineapple in airtight container at US\$16.530 million (13.3%), Fruit Concentrates at US\$15.903 million (12.8%), and Fresh Pineapples at US\$5.600 million (4.5%).


### United States of America was the top export commodity destination

The region's top export destination was *United States of America* with US\$47.756 million, a share of 38.4 percent. It was followed *Netherlands* by with US\$17.532 million (14.1%), *Japan* at US\$13.727 million (11.0%), *Spain* at US\$7.052 million (5.7%), and *Germany* at US\$5.518 million (4.4%).

The top export goods to the United States and Netherlands were *Other Crude Oil. Tuna in airtight containers* were the top export goods in Japan, Spain, and Germany.
