VOLUME AND VALUE OF IMPORTED AND EXPORTED GOODS, SOCCSKSARGEN REGION: SEPTEMBER 2021

Total external trade up

The external trade in goods in SOCCSKSARGEN Region totaled to US\$156.376 million in September 2021, increased by 11.3 percent from US\$140.485 million in September 2020 (Table 1).

Trade balance decrease

Balance of trade in goods (BoT-G) is the difference between the value of exports and imports. The BoT-G amounted to US\$59.365 million on September 2021, about 94.4 percent lower than the US\$30.542 million the same month of 2020 (Table 1).

Merchandise Trade

In September 2021, SOCCSKSARGEN exports totaled US\$107.870 million, up 26.1 percent from US\$85.514 million in September 2020. From September 2020 to September 2021, overall exports increased by 58.1 percent to 96.623 million kilograms. Imports totaled \$48.505 million in September 2021, down 11.8 percent from \$54.971 million the previous year. From 124.942 million kilograms in September 2020, imports totaled 159.429 million kilograms in September 2021. (Table 1).

Skipjack was the top import commodity

The top import commodity in September 2021 was Skipjack or striped bellied bonito which amounted to US\$9.096 million accounting for 18.8 percent of the total value of imports of the region. It was followed by Other flat rolled products of iron, plated or coated with tin of a thickness of less than 0.5 mm at US\$5.409 million (11.2%); Yellowfin tuna at US\$4.271 million (8.8%); Rice in husk, suitable for sowing at US\$1.472 million (3.0%); and Other Portland Cement at US\$1.466 million (3.0%). 


Japan was the largest source of import goods

The region's largest import source in September 2021 was Japan at US\$6.848 million accounting for 14.1 percent of the total imports of the region. It was followed by *Vietnam* at US\$5.809 million with 12.0 percent; *China* at US\$5.786 million (11.9%); *Korea* at US\$3.546 million (7.3%); and *Papua New Guinea* at US\$3.436 million (7.1%).

The leading imports in Japan was Other flat rolled products of iron plated or coated with tin, of a thickness of less than 0.5 mm, in terms of FOB. Other petroleum oils in Vietnam; Ammonium dihydrogenorthophosphate mineral or chemical fertilizers in China; and Skipjack or stripe-bellied bonito in Korea and Papua New Guinea (Figure 2).



Other Crude Oil were the top export goods

Other Crude Oil; Pineapples in airtight containers; Tunas in airtight containers; Fruit Concentrates, and Fresh Pineapples were the top five export goods in terms of FOB Value. Other Crude Oils were valued at US\$22.550 million (20.9%), Pineapples in airtight containers at US\$19.158 million (17.8%), Tunas in airtight containers at US\$14.997 million (13.9%), Fruit Concentrates at US\$11.360 million (10.5%), and Other tunas in airtight containers at US\$7.889 million (7.3%).




United States of America was the top export commodity destination

United States of America was the region's top export destination with a share of 30.1 percent, with US\$32.473 million. It was followed Japan by with US\$13.290 million (12.3%), Netherlands at US\$13.161 million (12.2%), Italy at US\$11.359 million (10.5%), and UK of Great Britain and N. Ireland at US\$4.947 million (4.6%).

The top export goods to the United States were Fruit Concentrates. In Japan and UK of Great Britain and N. Ireland were Tuna in airtight containers. Other Crude Oil were the top export goods in Netherlands and Italy.
