# VOLUME AND VALUE OF IMPORTED AND EXPORTED GOODS, SOCCSKSARGEN REGION: APRIL 2022

# Total external trade up

The external trade in goods in SOCCSKSARGEN Region in April 2022 totaled to US\$284.225 million, up by 77.0 percent from US\$160.557 million in April 2021 (Table 1).

#### Trade balance decrease

Balance of trade in goods (BoT-G) is the difference between the value of exports and imports. The BoT-G amounted to US\$85.176 million in April 2022, more than thrice the US\$23.655 million recorded in April 2021 (Table 1).

#### Merchandise Trade

Exports increased to US\$184.700 million in April 2022 more than twice the US\$92.106 million in April 2021. Total exports volume went up to 141.262 million kilograms in April 2022 from 74.578 million kilograms in April 2021. Import value rose by 45.4 percent to US\$99.524 million in April 2022 from US\$68.451 million in April 2021. Import volume increased to 176.690 million kilograms in April 2022 from 147.909 million kilograms the in April last year.



# Gas Oils was the top import commodity

Gas Oils were the top import commodity in April 2022, costing US\$23.913 million, or 24.0 percent of the region's overall import value. This was followed by Other Petroleum Oils at US\$16.939 million (17.0%); Skipjack or stripe-bellied bonito with US\$12.960 million (13.0%); Other Petroleum Oils with US\$7.527 million (7.6%); and Other flat-rolled products of iron, plated or coated with tin with US\$4.529 million (4.6%). 

### Malaysia was the largest source of import goods

Malaysia was the region's largest importer of goods at US\$17.821 million, accounting for 17.9 percent of total imports. South Korea came in second with US\$17.569 million (17.7%), followed by Taiwan with US\$16.943 million (17.0%), Papua New Guinea with US\$9.359 million (9.4%), and Japan with US\$9.340 million (9.4%).

Other Petroleum was the leading imports in Malaysia; *Gas Oils* in Korea and Taiwan; *Skipjack or stripe-bellied bonito* in Papua New Guinea; and *Other flat-rolled products of iron, plated or coated with tin, of a thickness of less than 0.5 mm* in Japan. (Figure 2)



# Other Crude Oils were the top export goods

Other Crude Oils, Tunas in airtight containers, Other Pineapple juice, Pineapples in airtight containers, and Other prepared and preserved fish were the top five export goods in terms of FOB Value. Other Crude Oils were valued at US\$75.931 million (41.1%), Tunas in airtight containers, US\$22.951 million (12.4%); Other Pineapple Juice, US\$16.461 million (8.9%); Pineapples in airtight containers, US\$13.402 million (7.3%), and Other prepared and preserved fish, US\$10.475 million (5.7%).


## Netherlands was the top export commodity destination

Netherlands was the region's top export market, accounting for 35.1 percent at \$64.789 million. Following it was the United States of America with US\$40.235 million (21.8%), Malaysia with US\$23.235 million (12.6%), Japan with US\$16.624 million (9.0%), and UK of Great Britain and North Ireland with US\$6.009 million (3.3%).

Other Crude Oils were the top exports in the Netherlands and Malaysia, Other Pineapple Juice in United States of America, Other frozen fish fillets in Japan, and Tunas in airtight containers in UK of Great Britain and North Ireland. (Figure 4)
