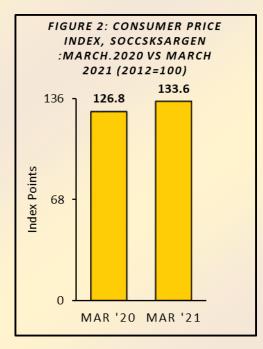


SPECIAL RELEASE SOCCSKSARGEN Headline Inflation Rate Up By 5.4% in March 2021

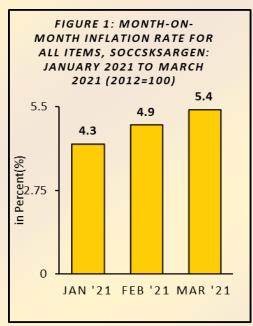
INDEX POINTS

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) For All Items in SOCCSKSARGEN in March 2021 was recorded at 133.6 index points. This indicates that the average retail price of commodities that were included in the market basket for all goods and services for the month under review was higher by 33.6% compared to its prices in its 2012 reference base year. The March 2020 CPI for All Items at 126.8 was higher by 6.8 index points compared to its March 2021 index (Figure 2).



INFLATION

Headline inflation rate or annual rate of change in the prices of goods and services in the market basket rose to 5.4% in March 2021 from 4.9% in February 2021. Headline Inflation for All items exhibited an uptrend starting from 4.3% in January 2021. (Figure 1)



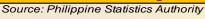
MARCH 2021 INFLATION RATE BY COMMODITY GROUP IN SOCCSKSARGEN REGION

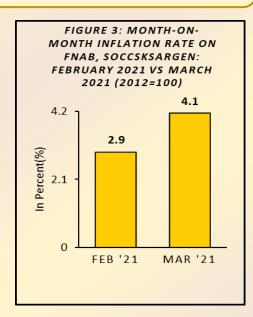
Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages (FNAB)

FNAB posted faster price increment of 4.1% in March 2021 from 2.9% in February 2021 (Figure 3). Faster price increments were recorded in Bread and Cereals, Rice Meat and Fish. Prices of Fruit, Vegetables, Sugar, Jam, Honey, Chocolate and Confectionery and Non-Alcoholic Beverages slowed down during the month under review. (Table 1).

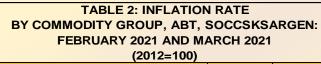

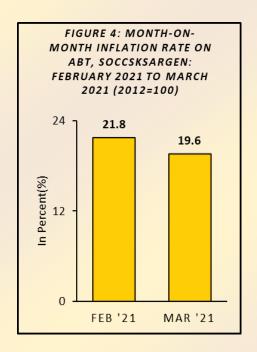
Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco (ABT)

ABT prices decreased to 19.6% in March 2021 from 21.8% in February 2021 (Figure 4). Both Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco registered slower price mark-ups during the month under review. Tobacco sustained double digit inflation. (*Table 2*).

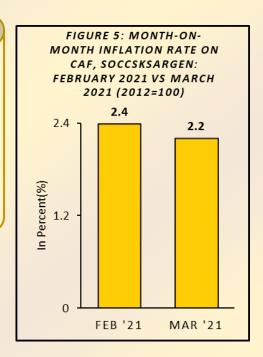

Clothing and Footwear (CAF)

Inflation rate for CAF slowed down from 2.4% in February 2021 to 2.2% in March 2021 (*Figure 5*) as prices of both Clothing and Footwear registered a slower price mark-ups during the month under review (*Table 3*).

Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels (HWEGOF)

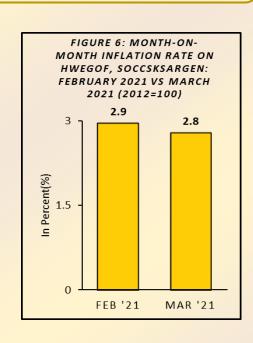
HWEGOF slightly decreased from 2.9% in February 2021 to 2.8% in March 2021. Maintenance and Repair of the Dwelling, Water Supply and Miscellaneous Services Relating to the Dwelling and Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels recorded slower price mark-up (Figure 6). Actual Rentals for Housing sustained its previous month's figures (*Table 4*).

Furnishings, Household Equipment and Maintenance of the House (FHERMH)

Slower price mark-ups for FHERMH was posted in March 2021 at a deflated figure of -9.2 % from 3.6% in February 2021 (Figure 7) as Furniture and Furnishings, Carpets and Other Floor Coverings, Household Appliances, Glassware, Tableware and Household Utensils exhibited higher price upticks. Price slowdowns were noted in Furniture and Furnishings, Carpets and Other Floor Coverings during the month under review (Table 5).

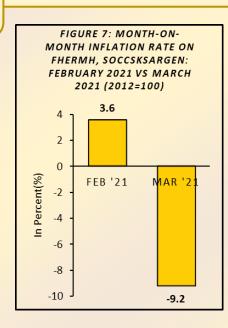

Health commodities and services posted a slower price increment of 3.3% in March 2021 from 4.1% in February 2021 (Figure 8). Prices of Medical Products Appliances and Equipment and Out-patient exhibited faster price mark-up. Hospital Services showed price mark down from 5.7% in February 2021 to 4.1% in

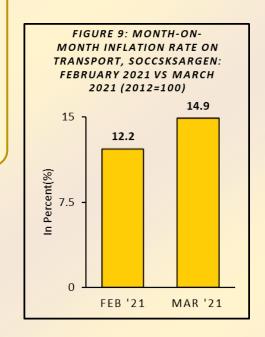

Transport recorded higher price uptick of 14.0% in February 2021 to 14.9% in March 2021 (Figure 9). Transport Services registered slower price mark-up as Operation of Personal Transport Equipment recorded higher price increment. Transport services was able to maintain double digit figures. (Table 7).

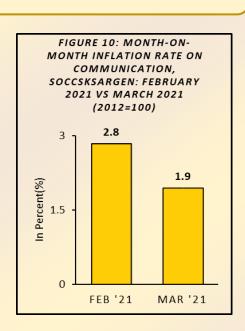


Communication

Communication posted slower inflation rate of 1.9% in March 2021 from 2.8% in February 2021 (*Figure 10*) as Telephone and Telefax Equipment posted slower price increment. Postal Services, Telephone and Telephax Services sustained their previous month's rates. (*Table 8*).

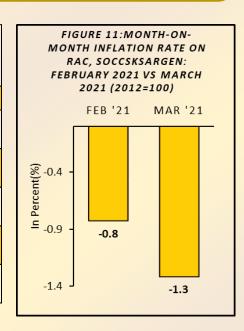
Recreation and Culture (RAC)

RAC sustained its negative price increment of 1.3% in March 2021 from -0.8% in February 2021 (Figure 11). Audio-visual, Photographic and Information Processing Equipment, Newspapers, Books and Stationery, Other Recreational Items and Equipment, Gardens and Pets posted a slower price mark-up. Higher price hike was noted in Other Major Durables for Recreation and Culture. Recreational and Cultural Services remained deflated and sustained its previous month's rate (Table 9).

Education

Education commodities and services sustained their previous month's figure of 3.0% during the month under review (*Figure 12*). Pre-primary and Primary Education, Secondary Education and Tertiary Education sustained its previous month's rate (Table 10).

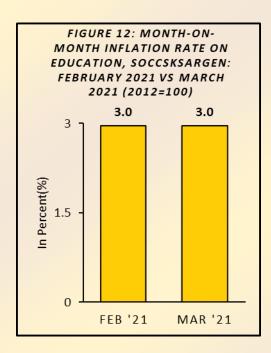

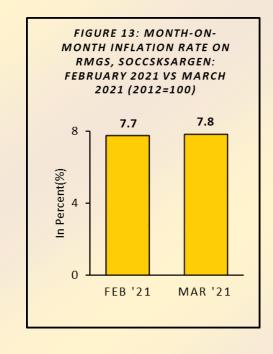

Restaurant and Miscellaneous Goods and Services (RMGS)

RMGS prices went up by 7.8% in March 2021 from 7.7% in February 2021 (*Figure 13*) as price of Personal Effects N.E.C and Catering Services recorded a faster price increment. A price slow down was noted in Personal Care during the month under review.

Prices for all items in the market basket in March 2021 eased during the month under review as slower price mark-ups were posted in ABT (21.8% to 19.6%), FHERMH (3.6% to -9.2%), CAF (2.4% to 2.2%), HWEGOF (2.9% to 2.8%), Health (4.1% to 3.3%), Communication (2.7% to 2.8%), RAC (-0.8% to -1.3%). Faster price upticks were recorded in FNAB (2.9% to 4.1%), Transport (12.2% to 14.9%), and RMGS (7.7% to 7.8%). Only RAC posted a deflation during the month under review while Education (3.0%) sustained its previous month's figure (*Table 12*).

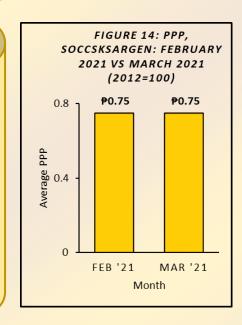

PURCHASING POWER OF PESO

The average Purchasing Power of Peso (PPP) in SOCCSKSARGEN in March 2021 sustained its previous month's figure of ₱0.75. This means that your ₱100.00 in March 2021 can only buy about 75.0% of the same basket of goods and services amounting to ₱100.00 in its 2012 reference base year (Figure 14).

INFLATION RATE BY PROVINCE IN SOCCSKSARGEN REGION

Inflation rate in the provinces of SOCCSKSARGEN Region in March 2021 was highest in Cotabato Province at 7.7%. Sarangani was at 5.8%, South Cotabato, 4.6% and Sultan Kudarat, 3.3%. The four provinces posted faster price increments during the month under review (*Table 13*).
