
SOCCSKSARGEN's Inflation Rate for the Bottom 30% Income Household Boosted to 1.4% in November 2019

YEAR-ON-YEAR INFLATION RATES

SOCCSKSARGEN Region's Inflation Rate for the Bottom 30% Household in November 2019 went up by 1.4 percent from 0.4 percent in October 2019. Among the commodity groups, Fuel, Light and Water posted the highest annual increase at 5.9% in November 2019. A month-onmonth slowdown of prices were recorded in Clothing (from 5.0% to 4.8%), Housing and Repairs (from 3.4% to 3.2%) and Services (from 3.6% to 3.1%). The highest inflation rate for 2019 was recorded in January at 4.4%.



E-mail: psadose@gmail.com https://rsso12.psa.gov.ph Food commodities rose by -1.5% in November 2019 from -2.8% in the previous month. At 8.9%, Fish recorded the highest inflation rate in the food commodity group similar to October 2019 at 8.9%. Higher annual price gains were also noted in Cereals (-10.5% from -12.1%), Rice (-10.0% from -12.1%), Cereal Preparations (2.0% from 1.9%) and Fruits and Vegetables (6.7% from 4.7%).

In contrast, slower price increases were observed in Corn (-12.2% to -12.8%), Dairy Products (2.4% to 2.2%), Eggs (2.0% to 1.6%) and Miscellaneous (2.2% to 1.9%).



CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, NOVEMBER 2019

The CPI for All Items for the Bottom 30% Income Households in SOCCSKSARGEN Region was noted at 241.5 index points in November 2019. The average retail price of goods and services in the market basket went up by 141.5 percent compared to the 2000-based year. This means that, on the average, about P241.5 is needed to purchase the same goods and services worth P100.00 in the 2000-based year.



Fuel, Light and Water (FLW) has remained to record the highest index point gains among the commodity groups. All the sub-groups of FLW has retained the same index points recorded in the previous month except for Light which decreased by 0.1 index point from 261.1 in October 2019 to 261.0 in November of the same year.
