


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
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The Municipality of Midsayap: Its population based on the result of the 2015 Census Of Population in August 1, 2015.


As of August 1, 2015, the population of Midsayap was 151,684. It was higher by 17,514 in 2010; 28,360 in 2007 and 45,924 in May 1, 2000. It ranked 2nd of the most populous municipality out of the 17 municipalities and 1 city of the province of Cotabato. It comprised 11% of the province's total population which was 1,379,747.

Reckoning the count two decades back, the count has increased by 54,913 in 2015.





The municipality has 57 barangays occupying a land area of 290.42 sq.kms of land which is 3.12% of the province area of 9,317.30 sq. kms. Population density as of August 1, 2015 was 522 persons per sq. km which was higher by 60 persons in 2010.

Among the 57 barangays of Midsayap, the top 5 most populous barangay as of August 1, 2015 were Sadaan, which accounted about 4.12 % of the municipality's total population, followed by Poblacion 8, Macasendeg, Kadigasan and Villarica. Macasendeg was the fastest growing barangay with an increase of 2,056 from 3,483 in 2010 to 5.539 in 2015. On the other hand, the least populous barangay was Bitoka with only 755 persons.



The household population was 99.44% of the total population of the municipalty with a number of households of 34,198 higher by 4,315 in 2010. Average household size decreased by 0.10 from 4.5 in 2010 to 4.4 in 2015.
