Household Population, Number of Households, and Average Household Size of City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato)

Household population of City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato) is up by 21,550

As of May 1 2020, the City of Kidapawan in Cotabato (North Cotabato) had a total population of 160,791 persons, with household population accounting for 99.53 percent of the total population, or 160,029 persons. This number of household population in 2020 is higher by 21,550 person compared to 140,195 household population recorded in 2015, and 35,344 person more than the 125,447 household population logged in 2010.


The remaining 0.474 percent of the total population is composed of the institutional population or those residing in a collective of institutional living quarters such as hospitals, orphanages, military camps; and of Filipinos in Philippine embassies, consulates, and missions abroad.

Number of households in the City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato) increases by 6,641 households

The total number of households in the City of Kidapawan increased to 39,891 in 2020. This is higher by 6,641 households compared with the 33,250 household in 2015 and by 10,993 compared with 28,898 households in 2010. Table 2 and Figure 2.

Twelve in every one hundred households resides in the City of Kidapawan, **Cotabato (North Cotabato)**

City of Kidapawan ranked first in the province of Cotabato (North Cotabato) in terms of number of households based on the results of the 2020 CPH with 39,891 households.

Almost 13 percent of the total number of households in Cotabato (North Cotabato) province in 2020 reside in City of Kidapawan.



Average household size of City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato) declines to 4.0 persons in 2020 from 4.2 in 2015

The average household size (AHS) of City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato) showed a declining trend from 4.3 persons in 2010, 4.2 persons in 2015 and 4.0 persons in 2020.

City of Kidapawan had the second lowest AHS of 4.0 persons in the province. The municipality of Banisilan had the highest AHS in Cotabato (North Cotabato) province at 4.4 persons.

Patadon (Patadon East) topped in terms of average household size (AHS) among the barangays in City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato)

The average household size (AHS) of Patadon (Patadon East) had the highest AHS among the barangays in City of Kidapawan, Cotabato (North Cotabato) with 4.6 persons. In contrary, barangay Sibawan posted the lowest AHS with 3.5 persons.
