Highlights of the Population of Glan, Sarangani Province 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH)

Date of Release: 04 March 2022

- As of 01 May 2020, the population of the municipality of Glan, including Filipinos in Philippine embassies, consulates, and missions abroad, is 109,547 persons based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH).
- The registered population of the municipality for 2020 decreased by 8,716 persons from the population of 118,263 in 2015. On the other hand, it is higher by 3,029 persons compared to the population of 106,518 in 2010. (Table 1)

- The population in Glan from 2015 to 2020 annually decreased by 1.60%. By comparison, the rate wherein the municipality's population declined from 2015 to 2020 was the lowest at -1.60%. (Table 2)

- With a total land area of approximately 533.51 square kilometers, the population density of Glan in 2020 was posted at 205 persons per square kilometer. This represents a decrease of only 17 person per square kilometer from the population density of 222 persons per square kilometer in 2015. In 2010, there were 200 persons residing in every square kilometer of land. (Table 3)

- In terms of population within the province of Sarangani, Glan was the most populated municipality among the seven municipalities with 109,547 persons.
- Among the 31 barangays in Glan, Barangay Poblacion was the most populous in 2020 with 7,582 persons, followed by Barangay Pangyan (6,858), then by Barangay Taluya (6,583), Barangay Baliton (6,108) and Barangay Datalbukay (6,069). (Table 4)


- The least populous barangay in Glan is Barangay Batotuling with 1,041 persons, followed by Barangay Rio Del Pilar (1,491), then by Barangay San Jose (1,664), Barangay New Aklan (1,811) and Barangay Lago (1,873). (Table 5)
