Highlights of the Population of Kiamba, Sarangani Province 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH)

Date of Release: 04 March 2022 Reference No. 22R1280-SR-004

- As of 01 May 2020, the population of the municipality of Kiamba, including Filipinos in Philippine embassies, consulates, and missions abroad, is 65,774 persons based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH).
- The registered population of the municipality for 2020 increased by 4,716 persons from the population of 61,058 in 2015 and is higher by 10,903 persons compared to the population of 54,871 in 2010. (Table 1)

 The population in Kiamba from 2015 to 2020 annually increased by 1.58%. The period wherein the municipality's population grew at a higher rate was between 2000 to 2010 at 2.06%. (Table 2)

 With a total land area of approximately 446.38 square kilometers, the population density of Kiamba in 2020 was posted at 147 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 10 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 137 persons per square kilometer in 2015. In 2010, there were 123 persons residing in every square kilometer of land. (Table 3)

- In terms of population within the province of Sarangani, Kiamba was the 5th most populated municipality among the seven municipalities with 65,774 persons.
- Among the 19 barangays in Kiamba, Barangay Poblacion was the most populous in 2020 with 12,714 persons, followed by Barangay Tambilil (6,325), then by Barangay Katubao (5,606), Barangay Lomuyon (5,555) and Barangay Nalus (5,038). (Table 4)

• The least populous barangay in Kiamba is Barangay Kling (Lumit) with 591 persons, followed by Barangay Lebe (1,025), then by Barangay Tablao (1,398), Barangay Luma (1,486) and Barangay Gasi (1,789). (Table 5)
