Highlights of the Population of Sarangani Province 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH)

Date of Release: December 2021 Reference No. 21R1280-SR-002

- As of 01 May 2020, the population of Sarangani, including Filipinos in Philippine embassies, consulates, and missions abroad is 558,946 persons based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH).
- The population for 2020 has increased by 14,685 persons from the population of 544,261 in 2015. While, population in 2020 is higher by 60,042 persons than the population of 498,904 in 2010. (Table 1)

• From 2015 to 2020, the population in Sarangani has increased by 0.56% annually. By comparison, the rate wherein the province's population grew from 2015 to 2020 was at the lowest at 0.56%. The annual population increase, however, was higher during the period 2000 to 2010 at 1.97%. (Table 2)

- In terms of population within the region, Sarangani ranked 5th among the provinces/cities, with 558,946 persons in 2020.
 - The province of Sarangani is constituted of seven municipalities and is further subdivided into 141 barangays.
 - Out of the seven municipalities in the province, Glan is the most populous in 2020 with a population of 109,547. It is followed by Malungon with 105,465 persons and Alabel with 88,294.
 - The municipality of Maitum had the smallest population with 44,185. (Table 3)

 Based on the annual population growth rate (PGR) of Sarangani, the fastest growing municipality is Alabel having a PGR of 2.00% from 2015 to 2020 followed by Maasim with a PGR of 1.87% and Kiamba with 1.58%. (Table 4)

 Among the barangays in the province of Sarangani, Barangay Poblacion, Alabel was the most populous barangay with 19,440 persons, followed by Barangay Poblacion, Malapatan with 16,259 persons, then by Barangay Malandag, Malungon (15,975), Barangay Kinam, Malapatan (12,779) and Barangay Poblacion, Kiamba (12,714). (Table 5)

 Barangay Seven Hills in Maasim had the smallest population size with 515 persons. This is followed by Barangay Kling (Lumit), Kiamba with 591 persons, then by Barangay Kibala, Malungon (757), Barangay Datal Bila, Malungon (885) and Barangay Lebe, Kiamba (1,025). (Table 6)
