Highlights of the Population Result of South Cotabato Province

Based on the results of the 2015 Census of Population *excluding General Santos City

Date of Release: 30 September 2021 Reference No.: SR – R1263 - 001

- As of 1 May 2020, the population of the province of South Cotabato is 975, 476 based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing results. This accounts for about 19.91 percent of the SOCCSKSARGEN population in 2020.
- The 2020 population is higher by 60,187 from the population of 915,289 in 2015, and 148,276 persons more than the 827,200 in 2010. Furthermore, it was higher by 284,748 persons compared to the population of 690,728 in 2000 (Table 1)

• The population of South Cotabato increased by 1.35 percent annually, on average, during the period of 2015 to 2020. By comparison, the rate at which the province's population grew during the period 2010 to 2015 was at 1.94 percent (Table 2)

- Among the ten municipality and one city, the City of Koronadal had the biggest population in 2020 with 195,398 persons, followed by Polomolok with 172,605 persons, and T'boli with 101,049 persons.
- Santo Niño had the smallest population with 39,796 persons (Table 3).

• The fastest growing municipality/city based on their annual population growth is the municipality of Polomolok with an annual population growth rate (PGR) of 2.63 percent from 2015 to 2020. It was followed by the City of Koronadal with 2.35 percent and T'Boli with 2.12 percent (Table 4).
