Highlights of the Population of the Municipality of Malapatan in Sarangani Province 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH)

Date of Release: 7 February 2022

As of 01 May 2020, the population of the municipality of Malapatan, including Filipinos in Philippine embassies, consulates, and missions abroad, is 80,741 persons based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH).

The population for 2020 has increased by 3,827 persons from the population of 76,914 in 2015. It is also more than 8,355 compared with the population of 72,386 in 2010. (Table 1)

From 2015 to 2020, the population of the municipality of Malapatan has increased by 1.03 % annually. The period wherein the municipality's population grew at a higher rate was between 2000 and 2010 at 3.0 %. (Table 2)

With a total land area of approximately 609.28 square kilometers, the population density of the municipality of Malapatan in 2020 was posted at 133 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 7 persons per square kilometer (5.0 %) from the population density of 126 persons per square kilometer in 2015. In 2010, there were 119 persons residing in every square kilometer of land. (Table 3)

The municipality of Malapatan ranked 4th among the municipalities in Sarangani Province, with 80,741 persons. It is composed of 12 barangays.

Out of the 12 barangays in the municipality of Malapatan, Poblacion was the most populous in 2020 with 16,259 persons, followed by Brgy. Kinam (12,779), then by Brgy. Lun Padidu (12,177). (Table 4)

In 2020, Brgy. Patag was the least populous barangay with 2,095 persons, followed by Brgy. Libi (2,195), then by Brgy. Sapu Padidu (2,853). (Table 5)
