Highlights of the Population of the Municipality of Malungon in Sarangani Province 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH)

Date of Release: 7 February 2022 Reference No. 22R1280-SR-002

As of 01 May 2020, the population of the municipality of Malungon, including Filipinos in Philippine embassies, consulates, and missions abroad, is 105,465 persons based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (2020 CPH).

The population for 2020 has increased by 1,861 persons from the population of 103,604 in 2015. It is also more than 10,421 compared with the population of 95,044 in 2010. (Table 1)

From 2015 to 2020, the population of the municipality of Malungon has increased by 0.38 % annually. The period wherein the municipality's population grew at a higher rate was between 2010 and 2015 at 1.65 %. (Table 2)

With a total land area of approximately 750.92 square kilometers, the population density of the municipality of Malungon in 2020 was posted at 140 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 2 persons per square kilometer (1.8 %) from the population density of 138 persons per square kilometer in 2015. In 2010, there were 127 persons residing in every square kilometer of land. (Table 3)

The municipality of Malungon ranked 2nd among the municipalities in Sarangani Province, with 105,465 persons. It is composed of 31 barangays.

Out of the 31 barangays in the municipality of Malungon, Malandag was the most populous in 2020 with 15,975 persons, followed by Brgy. Poblacion (9,882), then by Brgy. Tamban (8,278). (Table 4)

In 2020, Brgy. Kibala was the least populous barangay with 757 persons, followed by Brgy. Datal Bila (885), then by Brgy. Alkikan (1,204). (Table 5)
