Cotabato Province Headline Inflation down at - 1.0 percent in June 2025



YEAR-ON-YEAR INFLATION RATES

The headline inflation rate or the year-on-year change in the prices of goods and services commonly purchased by people in the province of Cotabato Province down at -1.0 percent in June 2025 from May 2025. This was lower than the regional level but higher than the national level at -0.9 percent and 1.4 percent respectively. This brings the province average inflation from January to June 2025 at 0.1 percent. The inflation in June 2024 was recorded at 3.7 percent. (Table 1 and Figure 1).

The downtrend inflation rate in Cotabato Province for the month of June 2025 was primarily brought about by decreased growth rate from the previous month in the index of Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages at -2.4percent from -1.3 percent; Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels at 1.7 percent from 2.8 percent; Clothing and Footwear at 0.8 percent from 1.1 percent and Personal Care, and Miscellaneous Goods and Services at 0.9 percent from 1.0 percent.

Meanwhile, The commodity group that exhibited an uptrend inflation rates during the month of June 2025 are the following: Furnishing, household equipment and routine household maintenance at **0.4 percent from 0.2 percent**; Health at **0.3 percent from 0.2 percent**; Transport at **-2.5 percent from -4.2 percent** and Recreation, sport and culture at **0.9 percent from 0.3 percent**.

On the other hand, the commodity groups that maintained their previous month's inflation rates or had zero percent annual growth are the following: (See Table 2).

- A. Alcoholic beverages and tobacco at **1.0 percent**;
- B. Information and Communication at **0.1 percent**;
- C. Education Services at **-0.3** percent;
- D. Restaurants and Accommodation Services at **0.4 percent**;
- E. Financial Services at **0.0 percent.**

In June 2025, the Food index down to **–2.8 percent** from **-1.5 percent** in May 2025.

The following food groups that exhibited downtrend during the month:

- 1. Fish and other seafood (ND) at -0.2 percent;
- 2. Cereals and cereal product (ND) at -15.8 percent;
- 3. Ready-made food and other food products n.e.c (ND) at -0.9 percent;
- 4. Oils and Fats (ND) at 4.1 percent;

On the contrary, below are the food groups that exhibited uptrend inflation during the month:

- 1. Meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals (ND) at **7.1 percent**;
- 2. Milk, other dairy products and eggs (ND) at 6.1 percent;
- 3. Fruits and nuts (ND) at 12.7 percent.
- 4. Vegetable, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses (ND) at 8.5 percent;
- 5. Sugar, confectionary and desserts (ND) at 2.6 percent.

Technical Notes

Headline Inflation Rate refers to the rate of change in the CPI, a measure of the average price of a standard basket of goods and services consumed by a typical family.

Base Period/Year this refers to the period, usually a year, at which the index number/points is set to 100. The current base period is 2018.

Consumer Price Index the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

Inflation Rate the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change in the CPI expressed

in percent.

Market basket refers to a sample of goods and services that are commonly purchased and

bought by an average Filipino household.

Weights a system that considers the relevance of the components of the index.
