For the Bottom 30% Income Households of Cotabato Province

MONTHLY INFLATION RATE (IR)



Inflation in Cotabato Province for the bottom 30% income households dropped to -1.8% in June 2025, down from -1.0% in the previous month. This decline indicates that the overall prices of basic goods and services typically consumed by the poorest segment of the population have decreased further, potentially easing the cost of living for low-income households in the area.

CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI)



The Consumer Price Index (CPI) in Cotabato Province for the bottom 30% income households decreased to 129.0 in June 2025 from 130.1 in the previous month. This decline suggests a general reduction in the prices of essential goods and services typically consumed by low-income households. In practical terms, this means that if you spent 100 pesos on a standard basket of goods and services in 2018, you would need 129.0 pesos to purchase the same items in June 2025. The decrease in CPI reflects a slight relief in the cost of living for the province's most economically vulnerable population.
